### PART I : GENERAL INFORMATION

2. <u>Manner of Depositing the Bids</u>. Tender to be submitted offline. Sealed Manual Bids to be dropped in the tender box, marked as <u>TENDER BOX</u> kept at Army Public School, Bathinda. Late tenders will not be considered. No responsibility will be taken for postal delay or non-delivery/non-receipt of Bid documents. Bids sent by FAX or e-mail will not be considered (unless they have been specifically called for by these modes due to urgency).

3. <u>Time and Date for Opening of Bids</u>. **31Oct 2023 at 1230 hrs.**If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of the Bids is declared a closed holiday, the Bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time or on any other day/time, as intimated by the Buyer.

4. <u>Location of the Tender Box</u>. Army Public School, Bathinda. Only those Bids that are found in the Tender Box will be opened. Bids dropped in the wrong Tender Box will be rendered invalid.

5. <u>Place of Opening of the Bids</u>. Army Public School, Bathinda. The Bidders may depute their representatives, duly authorized in writing, to attend the opening of Bids on the due date and time. Rates and important commercial/technical clauses quoted by all Bidders will be read out in the presence of the representative of all the Bidders. This event will not be postponed due to non-presence of your representative.

6. <u>**Two-Bid system.**</u> Only the Technical Bid would be opened on the time and date mentioned above. Date of opening of the Commercial Bid will be intimated after acceptance of the Technical Bids. Commercial Bids of only those firms will be opened, whose Technical Bids are found compliant/suitable after Technical evaluation is done by the Buyer.

7. **Forwarding of Bids**. Bids should be forwarded by Bidders under their original memo/ letter pad inter alia furnishing details like GST number, Bank address with EFT Account if applicable, etc and complete postal, contact Number & e-mail address of their office.

8. <u>Clarification regarding contents of the RFP</u>. A prospective bidder who requires clarification regarding the contents of the bidding documents shall notify to the Buyer in writing about the clarifications sought not later than 07 (seven) days prior to the date of opening of the Bids. Copies of the query and clarification by the purchaser will be sent to all prospective bidders who have received the bidding documents.

**Modification and Withdrawal of Bids**. A bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after submission, provided that, the written notice of modification or withdrawal is received by the Buyer prior to deadline prescribed for submission of bids. A withdrawal notice may be sent by e-mail but it should be followed by a signed confirmation copy sent by post and such signed confirmation should reach the purchaser not later than the deadline for submission of bids. No bid shall be modified after the deadline for submission of bids. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and expiration of the period of bid validity specified. Withdrawal of a bid during this period will result in Bidder's forfeiture of bid security.

10. <u>Clarification Regarding Contents of the Bids</u>. During evaluation and comparison of bids, the Buyer may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for clarification of his bid. The request for clarification will be given in writing and no change in prices or substance of the bid will be sought, offered or permitted. No post-bid clarification on the initiative of the bidder will be entertained.

11. <u>Rejection of Bids.</u> Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection with forfeiture of EMD. Conditional tenders will be rejected.

12. <u>Unwillingness to Quote</u>. Bidders unwilling to quote should ensure that intimation to this effect reaches before the due date and time of opening of the Bid, failing which the defaulting Bidder may be delisted for the given range of items as mentioned in this RFP.

13. <u>Validity of Bids</u>. The Bids should remain valid after 60 days from the last date of submission of the Bids.

14. **Earnest Money Deposit**. Bidders are required to submit Earnest Money Deposit for an amount of **Rs 23,000**/- (Rupees Twenty Three thousand only) along with their bids. The EMD may be submitted in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft, from any of the Public Sector Banks or a Private Sector Bank authorized to conduct government business. EMD is to remain valid for a period of thirty days beyond the final bid validity period. EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest, after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the award of the contract. The Bid security of the successful bidder would be returned, without any interest whatsoever, after the receipt of performance security from them as called for in the contract. The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amend, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of the tender.

(a) Exemption from Submission of Bid Security. Bid security is not required to be obtained from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME)/ MSEs registered with NSIC and under UdyogAadhaar Memorandum (UAM) and those firms who are registered with the Central Purchase Organisation or Departments/ Ministries of the Government of India for the same item/ range of products, goods or services for which the tenders have been issued.

3. <u>Two Bid Systems</u>. In respect of two bid system, bidders are required to furnish clause by clause compliance of specifications bringing out clearly the deviations from specification, if any. The bidders are advised to submit the compliance statement as per **Appx** 'A'along with technical bids.

4. <u>Delivery Period.</u> Delivery period for supply of items and installation of items would be 30 days from the effective date of contract. Please note that the contract can be cancelled unilaterally by the Buyer in case items are not received within the contracted delivery period. Extension of the contracted delivery period will be at the sole discretion of the Buyer, with applicability of LD clause.

#### THE BIDDER IS REQUIRED TO GIVE CONFIRMATION OF THEIR ACCEPTANCE OF THE STANDARD CONDITIONS OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL MENTIONED DA BELOW WHICH WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE CONTRACT CONCLUDED WITH THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER (I.E BIDDER IN THE CONTRACT) AS SELECTED BY THE BUYER. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN REJECTION OF THE BID SUBMITTED BY THE BIDDER.

1. **Law.** The Contract shall be considered and made in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India. The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.

2. <u>Effective Date of the Contract</u>. The contract shall come into effect on the date of signature of both the parties on the contract (effective date) and shall remain valid until the completion of the obligation of the parties under the contract. The deliveries, supplies and performance of the services shall commence from the effective date of the contract.

3. <u>Arbitration</u>. All disputes or differences arising out of, or in connection with the contract shall be settled by bilateral discussions. Any dispute, disagreement or question arising out of, or relating to the contract or relating to construction or performance, which cannot be settled amicably, may be resolved through arbitration. The standard clause of arbitration is as per Forms DPM-7, DPM-8 and DPM-9 (Available in MoD website and can be provided on request).

The Bidder undertakes that he has not Penalty for use of Undue influence. 4. given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly, any gift, consideration, reward, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any person in service of the Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Contracts or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India. Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the Bidder or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Bidder) or the commission of any offers by the Bidder or anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1986 or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the Buyer to cancel the contract and all or any other contracts with the Bidder and recover from the Bidder the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation. A decision of the Buyer or his nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on the Bidder. Giving or offering of any gift, bribe or inducement or any attempt at any such act on behalf of the Bidder towards any officer/employee of the Buyer or to any other person in a position to influence any officer/employee of the Buyer for showing any favour in relation to this or any other contract, shall render the Bidder to such liability/ penalty as the Buyer may deem proper, including but not limited to termination of the contract, imposition of penal damages, forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee and refund of the amounts paid by theBuyer.

5 <u>Agents/Agency Commission</u>. The Bidder confirms and declares to the Buyer that the Bidder is the original manufacturer of the stores/provider of the services referred to in this Contract and has not engaged any individual or firm, whether Indian or foreign whatsoever, to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Government of India or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially, to the award of the contract to the Bidder; nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual or firm in respect of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation.

The Bidder agrees that if it is established at any time to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the present declaration is in any way incorrect or if at a later stage it is discovered by the Buyer that the bidder has engaged any such individual/firm, and paid or intended to pay any amount, gift, reward, fees, commission or consideration to such person, party, firm or institution, whether before or after the signing of this contract, the Bidder will be liable to refund that amount to the Buyer. The Bidder will also be debarred from entering into any supply Contract with the Government of India for a minimum period of five years. The Buyer will also have a right to consider cancellation of the Contract either wholly or in part, without any entitlement or compensation to the Bidder who shall in such an event be liable to refund all payments made by the Buyer in terms of the Contract along with interest at the rate of 2% per annum above LIBOR rate. The Buyer will also have the right to recover any such amount from any contracts concluded earlier with the Government of India.

6. Access to Books of Accounts. In case it is found to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the Bidder has engaged an Agent or paid commission or influenced any person to obtain the contract as described in clauses relating to Agents/Agency Commission and penalty for use of undue influence, the Bidder, on a specific request of the Buyer, shall provide necessary information/ inspection of the relevant financial documents/information.

7. <u>Non-disclosure of Contract Documents</u>. Except with the written consent of the Buyer/ Bidder, other party shall not disclose the contract or any provision, specification, plan, design, pattern, sample or information thereof to any third party.

8. Liquidated Damages: In the event of the Bidder's failure to submit the bonds, Guarantees and documents, supply the stores/goods and conduct trials, installation of equipment, training etc as specified in this contract, the Buyer may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The BUYER may also deduct from the BIDDER as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5% of the contract price of the delayed/undelivered stores/services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed stores.

9. <u>Termination of Contract.</u> The Buyer shall have the right to terminate this Contract in part or in full in any of the following cases: -

(a) The delivery of the material is delayed for causes not attributable to Force Measure for more than **Three Months** after the scheduled date of delivery.

(b) The Bidder is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent.

(c) The delivery of material is delayed due to causes of Force Measure by more than **Three Months** provided Force Measure clause is included in contract.

(d) The Buyer has noticed that the Bidder has utilised the services of any Indian/Foreign agent in getting this contract and paid any commission to such individual/company etc.

(e) As per decision of the Arbitration Tribunal.

10. **Notice.** Any notice required or permitted by the contract shall be written in the English language and may be delivered personally or may be sent by FAX or registered pre-paid mail/airmail, addressed to the last known address of the party to whom it is sent.

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11. <u>**Transfer and Sub-letting.**</u> The Bidder has no right to give, bargain sell, assign or sublet or otherwise dispose of the Contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let a third party take benefit or advantage of the present Contract or any part thereof.

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12. **Patents and other Industrial Property Right**. The prices stated in the present contract shall be deemed to include all amounts payable for the use of patents, copyrights, registered charges, trademarks and payments for any other industrial property rights. The Bidder shall indemnify the Buyer against all claims from a third party at any time on account of the infringement of any or all the rights mentioned in the previous paragraphs, whether such claims arise in respect of manufacture or use. The Bidder shall be responsible for the completion of the supplies including spares, tools, technical literature and training aggregates irrespective of the fact of infringement of the supplies, irrespective of the fact of infringement of above.

13. <u>Amendments</u>. No provision of present Contract shall be changed or modified in any way (including this provision) either in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing made after the date of this Contract and signed on behalf of both the parties and which expressly states to amend the present Contract.

14. <u>Taxes and Duties.</u> The bidder shall clearly express in the bid, all the taxes, duties, Sale Tax and levies as applicable to the quote.

#### PART IV: SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF RFP

THE BIDDER IS REQUIRED TO GIVE CONFIRMATION OF THEIR ACCEPTANCE OF SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE RFP MENTIONED BELOW WHICH WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE CONTRACT CONCLUDED WITH THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER (I.E BIDDER IN THE CONTRACT) AS SELECTED BY THE BUYER. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN REJECTION OF BID SUBMITTED BY THE BIDDER.

1. <u>Performance Bank Guarantee(PBG)</u>. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a performance Guarantee by way of bank Guarantee through a public sector bank or a private sector bank authorized to conduct government business for a sum equal to 3% of the Supply Order/Contract value within 10 days of receipt of the confirmed order. Performance Bank Guarantee should be valid up to 60 days beyond the date of warranty. The specimen of PBG is given in form DPM-15 (available in MoD website and can be provided on request).

2. **Option Clause:** The contract will have an Option Clause, Wherein the Buyer can exercise an option to procure an additional 50% of the original contracted quantity in accordance with the same terms & conditions of the present contract. This will be applicable within the currency of contract. The Bidder is to confirm the acceptance of the same for inclusion in the contract. It will be entirely the discretion of the Buyer to exercise this option or not.

3. <u>**Repeat Order Clause**</u>. The Contract will have a Repeat Order Clause, wherein the Buyer can order upto 50% quantity of the items under the present contract within six months from the date of supply/successful completion of this contract, the cost, terms & conditions remaining the same. The Bidder is to confirm acceptance of this clause. It will be entirely the discretion of the Buyer to place the Repeat order or not.

4. <u>Tolerance Clause</u> To take care of any change in the requirement during the period starting from issue of RFP till placement of the contract, Buyer reserves the right 20% plus/minus increase or decrease the quantity of the required goods upto that limit without any change in the contract, the quantity ordered can be increased or decreased by the Buyer within this tolerance limit.

5. <u>Payment Terms</u>. 100% payment to be done after Acceptance Test Procedure (ATP) (Complete testing of the project).

7. <u>Advance Payment</u>. No advance payment to be made.

8. <u>Paying Authority</u>. (Name and address, Contact details). The payment of bills will be made on submission of the following documents by the Bidder to the Paying Authority along with the bill:-

(a) Ink signed copy of consignment bill/ Bidder's bill.

(b) Ink signed copy of commercial invoice/Bidder's bill.

(c) Copy of Supply Order/Contract with U.O. number and date of IFA's concurrence, where required under delegation of powers.

9. <u>Fall Clause.</u> The following Fall clause will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder: -

(a) The price charged for the stores supplied under the contract by the Bidder shall in no event exceed the lowest prices at which the Bidder sells the stores or offer to sell stores of identical description to any persons/Organisation including the purchaser or any department of the Central government or any Department of state government or any statutory undertaking the central or state government as the case may be during the period till performance of all Supply orders placed during the currency of the rate contract is completed.

(b) If at any time, during the said period the Bidder reduces the sale price, sells or offer to sell such stores to any person/organisation including the Buyer or any Deptt, of central Govt. or any Department of the State Government or any Statutory undertaking of the Central or state Government as the case may be at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract, the shall forthwith notify such reduction or sale or offer of sale to the Director general of Supplies & Disposals and the price payable under the contract for the stores of such reduction of sale or offer of the sale shall stand correspondingly reduced. The above stipulation will, however, not apply to:-

(i) Exports by the Bidder.

- (ii) Sale of goods as original equipment at price lower than the prices charged for normal replacement.
- (iii) Sale of goods such as drugs which have expiry dates.

(iv) Sale of goods at lower price on or after the date of completion of sale/placement of the order of goods by the authority concerned under the existing or previous Rate Contracts as also under any previous contracts entered into with the Central or State Govt. Depts, including their undertakings excluding joint sector companies and/or private parties and bodies.
