2. <u>Manner of Depositing the Bids</u>. Tender to be submitted offline. Sealed Manual Bids to be dropped in the tender box, marked as <u>TENDER BOX</u> ""Construction of **Synthetic Basketball Court**" kept at Army Public School, Bathinda. The bids will be sealed stamped and in a signed cover clearly mentioning the bidder's company. Late tenders will not be considered. Bids submitted manually by the bidders will be preferred, however if due to any urgency, bidders may resort to post the bids through registered post to APS, Bathinda. No responsibility will be taken for postal delay or non-delivery/non-receipt of Bid documents. Bids sent by FAX or e-mail will not be considered.

3. <u>Time and Date for Opening of Bids</u>. Time and Date for Opening of Bids 03 Apr 2024 at 1100 hrs. If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of the Bids is declared a closed holiday, the Bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time or on any other day/time, as intimated by the Buyer.

4. <u>Location of the Tender Box</u>. Army Public School, Bathinda. Only those Bids that are found in the Tender Box will be opened. Bids dropped in the wrong Tender Box will be rendered invalid.

5. <u>Place of Opening of the Bids</u>. Army Public School, Bathinda. The Bidders may depute their representatives, duly authorized in writing, to attend the opening of Bids on the due date and time. Rates and important commercial/technical clauses quoted by all Bidders will be read out in the presence of the representative of all the Bidders. This event will not be postponed due to non-presence of your representative.

6. <u>**Two-Bid system.**</u> Technical and commercial bids should be deposited in 02 separate sealed envelopes placed in third sealed envelope. Only the Technical Bid would be opened on the time and date mentioned above. Date of opening of the Commercial Bid will be intimated after acceptance of the Technical Bids. Commercial Bids of only those firms will be opened, whose Technical Bids are found compliant/suitable after Technical evaluation is done by the Buyer.

7. <u>Forwarding of Bids</u>. Bids should be forwarded by Bidders under their original memo/ letter pad inter alia furnishing details like GST number, Bank address with NEFT Account if applicable, etc and complete postal, contact Number & e-mail address of their office.

(a) Both the bids i.e Technical and Commercial Bid to be submitted in a separate envelop sealed stamped and signed by the vendor.

(b) Both the sealed Technical and Commercial Bids will be further enclosed in third envelop and same will be stamped, signed and sealed by bidders.

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Any bid which is found open or not enclosed with accordance of proper (c) procedure will be rejected.

requires clarification regarding the contents of the bidding documents shall notify to the Buyer in writing about the clarifications sought not later than 07 (seven) days prior to the date of opening of the Bids. Copies of the query and clarification by the purchaser will be sent to all prospective bidders who have received the bidding documents.

Modification and Withdrawal of Bids. A bidder may modify or withdraw his bid 9. after submission, provided that, the written notice of modification or withdrawal is received by the Buyer prior to deadline prescribed for submission of bids. A withdrawal notice may be sent by e-mail but it should be followed by a signed confirmation copy sent by post and such signed confirmation should reach the purchaser not later than the deadline for submission of bids. No bid shall be modified after the deadline for submission of bids. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and expiration of the period of bid validity specified. Withdrawal of a bid during this period will result in Bidder's forfeiture of bid security.

Clarification Regarding Contents of the Bids. 10. comparison of bids, the Buyer may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for clarification of his bid. The request for clarification will be given in writing and no change in prices or substance of the bid will be sought, offered or permitted. No post-bid clarification on the initiative of the bidder will be entertained.

Rejection of Bids. Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and 11. post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection with forfeiture of EMD. Conditional tenders will be rejected.

Unwillingness to Quote. Bidders unwilling to quote should ensure that intimation 12. to this effect reaches before the due date and time of opening of the Bid, failing which the defaulting Bidder may be delisted for the given range of items as mentioned in this RFP.

13. Validity of Bids. The Bids should remain valid after 60 days from the last date of submission of the Bids.

Earnest Money Deposit. Bidders are required to submit Earnest Money Deposit 14. at the rate of 2% of the quoted amount along with their bids. The EMD may be submitted in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft, from any of the Public Sector Banks or a Private Sector Bank authorized to conduct government business. EMD is to remain valid for a period of thirty days beyond the final bid validity period. EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest, after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract. The Bid security of the successful bidder would be returned, without any interest whatsoever, after the receipt of performance security from them as called for in the contract. The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amend, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of the tender.

Exemption from Submission of Bid Security. PART III: STANDARD CONDITIONS OF RFP

THE BIDDER IS REQUIRED TO GIVE CONFIRMATION OF THEIR ACCEPTANCE OF THE STANDARD CONDITIONS OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL MENTIONED BELOW WHICH WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE CONTRACT CONCLUDED WITH THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER (I.E BIDDER IN THE CONTRACT) AS SELECTED BY THE BUYER. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN REJECTION OF THE BID SUBMITTED BY THE BIDDER.

1. <u>Law.</u> The Contract shall be considered and made in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India. The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.

2. <u>Effective Date of the Contract</u>. The contract shall come into effect on the date of signature of both the parties on the contract (effective date) and shall remain valid until the completion of the obligation of the parties under the contract. The deliveries, supplies and performance of the services shall commence from the effective date of the contract.

3. <u>Arbitration</u>. All disputes or differences arising out of, or in connection with the contract shall be settled by bilateral discussions. Any dispute, disagreement or question arising out of, or relating to the contract or relating to construction or performance, which cannot be settled amicably, may be resolved through arbitration. The standard clause of arbitration is as per Forms DPM-7, DPM-8 and DPM-9 (Available in MoD website and can be provided on request).

4. Penalty for use of Undue influence. The Bidder undertakes that he has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly, any gift, consideration, reward, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any person in service of the Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Contracts or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India. Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the Bidder or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Bidder) or the commission of any offers by the Bidder or anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1986 or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the Buyer to cancel the contract and all or any other contracts with the Bidder and recover from the Bidder the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation. A decision of the Buyer or his nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on the Bidder. Giving or offering of any gift, bribe or inducement or any attempt at any such act on behalf of the Bidder towards any officer/employee of the Buyer or to any other person in a position to influence any officer/employee of the Buyer for showing any favour in relation to this or any other contract, shall render the Bidder to such liability/ penalty as the Buyer may deem proper, including but not limited to termination of the contract, imposition of penal damages, forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee and refund of the amounts paid by the Buyer.

5 <u>Agents/Agency Commission</u>. The Bidder confirms and declares to the Buyer that the Bidder is the original manufacturer of the stores/provider of the services referred to in this Contract and has not engaged any individual or firm, whether Indian or foreign whatsoever, to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Government of India or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially, to the award of the contract to the Bidder; nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any

such individual or firm in respect of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation. The Bidder agrees that if it is established at any time to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the present declaration is in any way incorrect or if at a later stage it is discovered by the Buyer that the bidder has engaged any such individual/firm, and paid or intended to pay any amount, gift, reward, fees, commission or consideration to such person, party, firm or institution, whether before or after the signing of this contract, the Bidder will be liable to refund that amount to the Buyer. The Bidder will also be debarred from entering into any supply Contract with the Government of India for a minimum period of five years. The Buyer will also have a right to consider cancellation of the Contract either wholly or in part, without any entitlement or compensation to the Bidder who shall in such an event be liable to refund all payments made by the Buyer in terms of the Contract along with interest at the rate of 2% per annum above LIBOR rate. The Buyer will also have the right to recover any such amount from any contracts concluded earlier with the Government of

Access to Books of Accounts. In case it is found to the satisfaction of the Buyer 6. that the Bidder has engaged an Agent or paid commission or influenced any person to obtain the contract as described in clauses relating to Agents/Agency Commission and penalty for use of undue influence, the Bidder, on a specific request of the Buyer, shall provide necessary information/ inspection of the relevant financial documents/information.

Non-disclosure of Contract Documents. 7. the Buyer/ Bidder, other party shall not disclose the contract or any provision, Except with the written consent of specification, plan, design, pattern, sample or information thereof to any third party.

Liquidated Damages: In the event of the Bidder's failure to submit the bonds, 8. Guarantees and documents, supply the stores/goods and conduct trials, installation of equipment, training etc as specified in this contract, the Buyer may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The BUYER may also deduct from the BIDDER as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5% of the contract price of the delayed/undelivered stores/services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed stores.

Termination of Contract. The Buyer shall have the right to terminate this 9 Contract in part or in full in any of the following cases: -

Notice. Any notice required or permitted by the contract shall be written in the 10. IBLIC English language and may be delivered personally or may be sent by FAX or registered pre-paid mail/airmail, addressed to the last known address of the party to whom it is sent.

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11. Transfer and Sub-letting.

The Bidder has no right to give, bargain, sell, assign or sublet or otherwise dispose of the Contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let a third party take benefit or advantage of the present Contract or any part thereof.

12. Patents and other Industrial Property Right. contract shall be deemed to include all amounts payable for the use of patents, copyrights, The prices stated in the present registered charges, trademarks and payments for any other industrial property rights. The Bidder shall indemnify the Buyer against all claims from a third party at any time on account of the infringement of any or all the rights mentioned in the previous paragraphs, whether such claims arise in respect of manufacture or use. The Bidder shall be responsible for the completion of the supplies including spares, tools, technical literature and training aggregates irrespective of the fact of infringement of the supplies, irrespective of the fact of infringement of any or all the rights mentioned above.

13. Amendments. No provision of present Contract shall be changed or modified in any way (including this provision) either in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing made after the date of this Contract and signed on behalf of both the parties and which expressly states to amend the present Contract.

Taxes and Duties. The bidder shall clearly express in the bid, all the taxes, 14. duties, Sale Tax and levies as applicable to the quote.

PART IV: SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF RFP

1. <u>Performance Bank Guarantee(PBG)</u>. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a performance Guarantee by way of bank Guarantee through a public sector bank or a private sector bank authorized to conduct government business for a sum equal to 5% of the Supply Order/Contract value within 10 days of receipt of the confirmed order. Performance Bank Guarantee should be valid up to 60 days beyond the date of warranty. The specimen of PBG is given at Appendix 'C'.PBG should be in favour of Consignee which will be retained by the buyer and shall be released only after successful expiry of warranty period of three year from the date of completion of project.

2. **Option Clause:** The contract will have an Option Clause, Wherein the Buyer can exercise an option to procure an additional 50% of the original contracted quantity in accordance with the same terms & conditions of the present contract. This will be applicable within the currency of contract. The Bidder is to confirm the acceptance of the same for inclusion in the contract. It will be entirely the discretion of the Buyer to exercise this option or not.

3. <u>Repeat Order Clause</u>. The Contract will have a Repeat Order Clause, wherein the Buyer can order upto 50% quantity of the items under the present contract within six months from the date of supply/successful completion of this contract, the cost, terms & conditions remaining the same. The Bidder is to confirm acceptance of this clause. It will be entirely the discretion of the Buyer to place the Repeat order or not.

4. <u>Tolerance Clause</u> To take care of any change in the requirement during the period starting from issue of RFP till placement of the contract, Buyer reserves the right 20% plus/minus increase or decrease the quantity of the required goods upto that limit without any change in the contract, the quantity ordered can be increased or decreased by the Buyer within this tolerance limit.
