General Instructions:- (Online mode)

1. 8th March will be a preparatory holiday.
2. Please ensure that your net connectivity is good and all the technical issues are resolved before the exams.
3. Students are required to login in MS Teams 10 minutes earlier than the scheduled time for the exam.
4. Start the exam on time.
5. Duration of Current Affairs and Computer exam is 50 minutes.
6. Students will have pen & paper test of 3 hours duration. Students will download the question paper from the Assignment Tab in MS Teams. They will write the answers on the sheets provided by the school. Students will make a single pdf of the answer sheet(s) (Max. size allowed is up to 50MB) and will upload the same in the Assignment Tab under the option 'Add Work'.

7. Additional 60 minutes will be given for scanning the answer sheet and uploading the pdf. First 45 minutes will be given for uploading the pdf in the Assignment Tab. If any student is unable to upload the file there, he/she will send the same pdf to the respective subject teacher on his/her Email in the next 15 minutes. The content in the pdf file should be readable. Students will cancel all the blank pages before creating the pdf and even the cancelled pages will have to be scanned to the pdf file.

8. Submit your work within the given time limit otherwise the answer sheets will not be considered for evaluation.

9. After you upload the pdf under 'Add Work', ensure that your work has been handed in successfully.

10. Students are requested not to log out of the Teams app till the completion of the exam and stay logged in till their file is uploaded. Students shall wait for the confirmation from the Invigilator.

11. There will be no classes during the exam schedule i.e. 09 March – 26 March 2021.

General Instructions (Offline mode)

1. 8th March will be a preparatory holiday.

2. Reporting time for students is 11:30 A.M. on the day of examination.

3. Students will make their own arrangements to reach the school during exam days.

4. In case the child is coming from civil area on his own, a written information/consent from the parent is must. Further if the child is coming to school on a two wheeler, he/she must be in possession of a valid driving license (learner's license).

5. Examination time is 12:00 P.M. to 03:00 P.M.

6. Dispersal will be at 3:30 PM.
